UPI Payments: 0.40 % + GST 18%

STOP / CANCEL / RESTART OF ENACH MANDATE

ENACH mandate registered parents are given facility to stop / cancel / restart of ENACH mandate. Parents will submit their request to school by filling Google form.

On receiving the request, the school management will take final decision on accepting or rejecting the received request. Parents will be given an alternative option to pay school fees.

Parents should submit the google form to stop / cancel / restart of ENACH mandate 15 days prior to fee installment payment date as per the fee payment schedule. Request received later will not be processed.
